



Road to Graduation Scholarship Program

This scholarship program is designed to provide assistance to eligible students who have withdrawn from school, have a previous balance with RSI, and want to re-enter and consequently graduate from the program. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Scholarship Amounts:

- Scholarship amounts vary. The maximum award per student is \$500.

Eligibility Requirements:

The Applicant must:

- Be enrolled in a RSI program with an expected re-enter date in September or October 2013;
- Only the Electro-Mechanical Technologies or AOS in Mechanical Maintenance Engineering programs are eligible for this scholarship;
- Have a balance from a previous or current enrollment at RSI;
- Write a brief essay about why they withdrew, how they have rectified the issue(s) that resulted in their withdrawal, and how completing the program will help them reach their goals;
- Apply for all available agency, state, and federal student aid;
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress; and
- Maintain continuous enrollment and result in graduation.

Number of Scholarships available per start and per student:

- Scholarships are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis and will be awarded upon graduation from the program.

Deadline:

- Applications must be submitted prior to starting classes.

If a student changes his/her re-enter date, his/her scholarship award may be forfeited.

This scholarship is not transferrable and cannot be used in conjunction with any other scholarship TWS offers. Only one award will be given per student. If a student is eligible for multiple scholarships, the scholarship that is most beneficial to the student will be awarded.

Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this scholarship, which may increase your tuition obligation to TWS. Tuition charges will be based on the amount reflected on your Enrollment Agreement. See the reverse side of your enrollment agreement for the school's refund policy.

Our Policy

Any student meeting the scholarship criteria may apply. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student. This scholarship is not transferrable. It will be applied to the student's account upon graduation from the program. The maximum award is \$500, and is based on their previous balance with RSI.

Students must complete this request form and submit it with their essay to the Scholarship Selection Committee to be considered. Of the requests received, each will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Of those eligible requests, the awards will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

This scholarship program is based on the enrolled student's re-enter date. There are a limited number of scholarships to be awarded. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student. If a student changes his re-enter date, his/her scholarship award may be forfeited.
